Communicable Disease Protocol

Our Lady of Peace School Gym – 40 E. Dominion Rd, Columbus Ohio

General Protocols

- Game day maximum capacity (including Players, Spectators, Volunteers and Officials): 116
- Event attendees will be tracked by use of facility schedule
 - Individual team roster to be maintained by DRA
- Signage:
 - General communication of CDC and ODH protocols will be posted throughout
 - 6 foot spacing will be posted in areas where lines may form (entrance or concession area for example)
 - Facility Entrance and Exit signs will be posted outdoor and indoor respectively
 - Restroom Entrance and Exit signs will be posted
 - Directional Flow signs will be posted throughout
- Nonperformance of social distancing will be removal from the event
- Masks will always be worn outside of on the court activities
- Volunteers and gym workers will always be required to wear masks

Facility Flow

- Entrance: Under blue awning located NE of the gym
- Exit: Double doors located at the SW end of the gym
- Single direction flow to occur throughout
 - Behind bleachers: East to West
 - In Front of bleachers: West to East
- Restroom entrance to occur from gym entrance and exit in hallway to reenter gymnasium

Cleaning and Disinfecting

- EPA approved COVID disinfectant will be used for all cleaning
- Bleachers and Player benches will be disinfected between each game
- Restroom high touch surfaces will be disinfected between each game
- Doors handles, scorer's table and other high touch surfaces will be disinfected between each game
- All sports equipment will be disinfected between each game

Spectators

- Spectators will be advised (via signage) that they are not to attend if they have the following symptoms:
 - Fever
 - Cough
 - Sore Throat
 - Shortness of Breath
 - Exposure to an individual with COVID19
- Mask will be required the entire time
- Listen and conform to all requirements of the Social Distancing Coordinator, referee and coaches
- Stay in cars until 15 minutes before a scheduled game,
 - Limit spectators to immediate household members
- Upon entrance take highest bleacher seat available across court from your team
- Sit in groups of two where marked
 - No seating in “X” locations – this is the social distance indicator
- Quickly exit the gym after a game
 - Do not congregate with other parents on the sideline not in your immediate family

Players and Coaches

- All players on the sidelines will be required to wear masks
- All players and coaches will answer the COVID tracking questions and documentation will be maintained for each event:
 - Do you have a fever?
 - Do you have a cough?
 - Do you have a sore throat?
 - Are you experiencing shortness of breath?
 - Have you been exposed to anyone who is positive with COVID19?
 - What is your temperature if $> 100.4^{\circ}$?
- Coaches will always wear masks
- Players seats will be separated six feet apart for social distancing
- Players are not to share equipment or water bottles

Ticketing and Concession

- All individuals completing monetary transactions will wear gloves
- All concession items will be individually packaged
- Any food or drink consumed by an individual must be done so in socially distanced seated position

Enforcement

- Nonperformance of social distancing will be removal from the event
- Social distancing and enforcement of policies within will be the responsibility of assigned daily gym supervisor
 - (OLPAA Board Member – list available upon request)

General Protocols

- Game day maximum capacity (including Players, Spectators, Volunteers and Officials): 120 per event
- Event attendees will be tracked by use of game schedule
 - Individual team roster to be maintained by DRA and COYSL respectively
- Signage:
 - General communication of CDC and ODH protocols will be posted throughout
 - 6-foot spacing requirement will be posted
- Nonperformance of social distancing will be removal from the event
- Masks will always be worn outside of on the field activities
- Volunteers and officials will always be required to wear masks

Facility

- Spectators must Stay seated on the sidelines and maintain social distancing
 - Fans to sit on the side of the field of their associated team
- No restrooms will be provided by OLPAA
- No concessions will be provided by OLPAA
- No pets are allowed at any of our events
- A sanitation station will be present for each event

Cleaning and Disinfecting

- EPA approved COVID disinfectant will be used for all cleaning
- All sports equipment will be disinfected between each game

Spectators

- Spectators are asked to stay in cars until 10 minutes before a scheduled game,
 - Limit spectators on sideline to immediate household members
- Spectators will be advised (via signage) that they are not to attend if they have the following symptoms:
 - Fever
 - Cough

- Sore Throat
- Shortness of Breath
- Exposure to an individual with COVID19
- Mask will be required the entire time
- There will be no available fixed seating, spectators can bring their own chairs, blankets, etc.
 - Spectators are to sit with their immediate family group allow for 6 feet spacing between families
 - Signage reminding of the 6-foot requirement will be posted
- Listen and conform to all requirements of the Social Distancing Coordinator, referee, coach
- Quickly exit the fields after a game
 - Do not congregate with other parents on the sideline not in your immediate family

Players and Coaches

- All players on the sidelines will be required to wear masks
- Coaches will always wear masks
- All players and coaches will answer the COVID tracking questions and documentation will be maintained for each event:
 - Do you have a fever?
 - Do you have a cough?
 - Do you have a sore throat?
 - Are you experiencing shortness of breath?
 - Have you been exposed to anyone who is positive with COVID19?
 - What is your temperature if $> 100.4^{\circ}$?
- Players seats will be separated six feet apart for social distancing
 - Cones, markers or players bags may be used to delineate spacing
- Players are not to share equipment or water bottles

Enforcement

- Nonperformance of social distancing will be removal from the event
- Social distancing and enforcement of policies within will be the responsibility of assigned daily field supervisor
